



2011 METROWEST FUND FOR ARTS AND CULTURE

PURPOSE

Foundation for MetroWest announces the availability of grant funds from the **MetroWest Fund for Arts and Culture** for 2011.

The purpose of the grant award is to assist visual and performing arts organizations, cultural organizations including historic preservation in MetroWest.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Preferences will be given to proposals which:

- Support activities that contribute to the cultural vitality and quality of life in the community.
- Demonstrate the ability to address diverse cultural needs of the MetroWest's underserved populations.
- Present innovative, entrepreneurial, practical and achievable projects
- Present clear work plans illustrating the ability to achieve the project's goal(s)
- Focus on strategic innovations that encourage collaboration, cooperation, create efficiencies, and reduce duplication of services. Collaborations may take place with other nonprofit organizations and/or with for-profit entities.
- Confirm that the organization is financially stable, with no overwhelming threats to continued viability
- Substantiate experienced leadership, at both the staff and board levels
- Explain clearly how the funds will be used
- Provide a plan for sustainability beyond the funding period
- Sponsorship of free events, individual performances will receive lowest funding priority.

ELIGIBILITY

- Eligible applicants must be recognized under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code
- Schools and public agencies are not eligible
- Applicants purpose and programs must serve the MetroWest community as defined by the Foundation (Acton, Ashland, Boxborough, Carlisle, Concord, Dedham, Dover, Framingham, Harvard, Holliston, Hopkinton, Hudson, Lexington, Lincoln, Marlborough, Maynard, Medfield, Medway, Milford, Millis,

Natick, Needham, Sherborn, Southborough, Stow, Sudbury, Walpole, Waltham, Wayland, Wellesley, Westborough, Weston and Westwood)

- Proposals may be submitted for new or existing projects, programs, or operating purposes. To encourage collaboration, two or more organizations may submit a joint proposal in addition to a proposal exclusively for their own purposes.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS & DEADLINE

Note: Only applications that adhere to the following instructions will be considered.

- Applications **must be sent electronically**. The application form is available [on our website](#).
- Project and operating budgets **must be submitted electronically**. Please use the [Associated Grant Makers Project and Budget Summary Form](#).

- Your IRS Determination Letter and your most recent audited financial report or 990, **must be sent by hardcopy** and postmarked by **August 12th, 2011** by U.S. Post Office to:

AWARDS

Grant requests of **up to \$10,000** will be considered. Funding is contingent upon the organization's successful evaluation and reporting of past grant awards from the Foundation for MetroWest. **Applications will not be considered if any previous year reporting has not been completed.**
